He is currently building shelters for women and girls in India, Peru, Guatemala and Colombia, and his work also takes him frequently to Africa as well as other parts of Latin America and Asia.

Lee spends much of his time mentoring the next generation of Christian leaders.

He is the author of 10 Lies the Church Tells Women, Fearless Daughters of the Bible, The Truth Sets Women Free, The Holy Spirit Is Not for Sale, 10 Lies Men Believe and his newest book, Set My Heart on Fire—which is a Bible study on the Holy Spirit. His next book, Follow Me, shares his passion for relational discipleship.

Lee has addressed conferences and conducted outreaches in more than 30 nations. He lives in LaGrange, Georgia with his wife, Deborah. They have four grown daughters and three grandchildren.
